Mr Jones will be in the U.K from the 8th to the 15th February recruiting new teachers for September 2012.

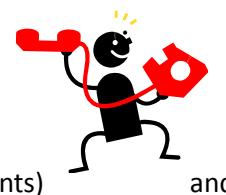
4 WEEK INTERVIEWS FOR NEW FAMILIES
