On Thursday evening at 6 p.m, they will perform to their parents, family and friends at the Wawasan Open University.

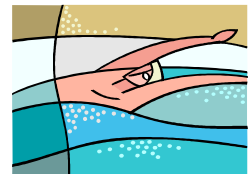


UPLANDS YEAR 10 STUDENTS
