Dear Parents

On Friday evening the school held its 57th Annual General Meeting (AGM). I would like to acknowledge all the Governors for their continual support, guidance and advice as well as thank all the parents who attended and contributed with positive and constructive feedback and suggestions to the meeting. At the meeting, governors talked about the changing landscape of education on Penang, and with the information collected in the SWOT survey as well as the recommendation from our British Schools Overseas Inspection, a strategic planning meeting will be held in the coming months.

Next week we welcome a number of visitors to the school. Firstly all the new teachers employed for August will be in school on their Look and See visit. A great opportunity for them to get to know the school, the children, the staff and Penang. Secondly, we will be hosting three Penata inspectors, who will be in school as we undertake our reaccreditation with British Schools Overseas. As mentioned above, the recommendations from this inspection will be a key element in the constructing of a new development plan.

Coronavirus

We are mindful that next Friday, 21st February, is the last day of school before we have a half-term break. If you are travelling outside of Malaysia during this time, please check the travel advice of the country you are transiting through as well as your final destination.

You may be required to self-isolate for a set period even if you do not have symptoms. either when arriving in another country or returning to Malaysia. Specific recommendations are already in place when entering Malaysia for those travelling to and from mainland China, including Hong Kong and Macau.

A reminder to all that in line with advice from the Ministry of Health, that anyone travelling to China including Hong Kong and Macau, will be required to spend a period of 14 days in isolation back in Malaysia before returning to School. Evidence of the 14 day incubation period will need to be submitted to the school before students can return to class.

We will be holding a School Disco on Friday 6th March 5.00 pm - 8.00 pm. This year the Prefects have themed it 'Disney'. Events such as this enable the school community to come together and relax. As usual, there will be food and drinks on sale.
