Dear Parents,

All school staff are looking forward to seeing the children return to school on Monday 8th March. This week everyone has been busy preparing the classrooms and school campus for their return.

The information here will support a smooth transition for you and your child back to school.

Google Classroom

With students now able to return to face to face learning, we will only be posting core tasks each day on the Google Classroom. The class teachers will be fully engaged when back in school, so there will be no online conferencing.

Face Masks / Shields

The new MOE SOP's ask that parents encourage children to wear their face masks/shields at all times. Our policy regarding masks/shields will remain the same; we will continue to encourage all children to wear them, and everyone will wear them when moving around the classroom and the school. Teachers will wear a face mask/shield whenever close to the children.

Pick Up and Drop Off

With a return to CMCO, we still encourage parents to drive through for drop off and pick up. However, should you feel the need to walk your child to the front of the school, you may park your car and do so. Please do not wait around after drop off.

We will return to the staggered pick-up times, which worked successfully before the MCO. These are as follows:

We will continue to offer sibling pick up, so please contact the class teachers, so that the necessary arrangements can be made.
