Dear Parents,

Starting the term online was not what anyone wanted, but finishing the term with all children in school has been excellent. I appreciate the complications parents will face with the rotation system, but enabling all children to come into school every day, has supported their learning and well-being. Thank you.

I am sure you will be wondering if we will be able to return to regular schooling or have to stay with the morning and afternoon sessions when we start next term. It is tough to predict. I continue to seek MOE guidance on these matters and hope that the COVID situation continues to stabilise and restrictions on school are eased or lifted when considered safe to do so. I will write to you all before the new term giving an update and confirming the arrangements.

### Parking Around School

I would like to remind all parents to consider other road users, when dropping off and picking up children from school. In particular, parking outside the school gates and on the corner of junctions makes it difficult for cars to see or turn around the corner or into school. Your support is appreciated and will help everyone when we finally have all the children returning for the whole school day.

### School Uniform

I would like to ask everyone now we are back in school to ensure the children follow the [Student Dress Code](#). Thank you in advance for supporting the school rules.

Your child will be dismissed at the usual time.
